Introduction

On Saturday 9th November 2019 Northbrook Athletic Club, Sphinx Athletic Club and Nuneaton Harriers Athletic Club are jointly hosting the first fixtures for Division Two of the Midlands Women's Cross Country League and Division Three of the Birmingham and District Invitation Cross Country League. The event is to take place in Coundon Hall Park, Coventry. The park is a Public Space under the control of Coventry City Council (permission for use agreed).

The Event will be held under the current, MWCC League and the B&DICC League Rules and relevant UK Athletics "Rules for Competition".

Management

The site is managed by Coventry City Council.

Control of the **fixed facilities**, **course and race** will be managed by the Promoters, in conjunction with the Referee provided by the B&DICC League.

Race HQ

Race HQ, for Registration, Refreshments and Results, will be adjacent to Start and Finish area as shown on Plan of the Course.

Changing Facilities

Changing, showers and toilets are available, in the park, adjacent to Main Car Park, off the Tamworth Road. The facilities are basic and all in one block with **no separation for Women/Men**. So we will be providing additional toilet facilities with Portable units.

Location

We have used Coundon Hall Park, many times over the years so many of you will know how to find your way there. For those new to the area, a map and directions are also associated to assist (Sat Nav users try **CV6 2EJ**). The details will also be on our websites (www.northbrookac.org.uk; www.sphinx.org.uk and www.nuneatonharriers.org.uk) and that of the B&DICC League (www.birminghamccleague.co.uk). So Clubs and their Members will be able to download their own copies if required.

Parking

Please share vehicles as much as possible to reduce demand for parking spaces.

The park is open to the public and is used extensively. We have not been able to obtain use of any of the local Schools, as previously, so the whole event will be in the park. Because of this, and because women's and men's leagues are involved, parking will be at a premium. Main Car Parking, and that for Officials (74 spaces), is next to Changing/Showers, which is located off the Tamworth Road (opposite Sandpits Lane). There is another Car Park in Waste Lane (38 marked spaces). If using either of these, please be considerate and avoid blocking-in other park users. There are few restrictions to "on street" parking along Tamworth Road and Brownshill Green Road. Do not try to park on Waste Lane or Long Lane. Club Coaches should drop off passengers in Waste Lane and park-up elsewhere. Please share vehicles as much as possible to reduce demand for parking spaces. Subject to ground conditions, we may be able to use part of a field for parking but this is not guaranteed.

The Course (see associated Plan)

The course is a Municipal Park in the City of Coventry. The majority of the park is grassland. However there has been a lot of tree planting and drainage work done over the past couple of years, so some areas have changed dramatically. The grass is regularly cut during the summer and the surface, in general, is fairly even. There is a general overall gradient, falling from the North corner (point E) to the South corner (point V), with a noticeable dip and rise between points C and D. The proposed course for the race follows the perimeter, in the main, and is designed not to incur on the marked pitches. The small and large spinneys, in the park, have been included as part of the course subject to race-day conditions. Please note that; since planning the Course, the L.A. have started laying another gravel path. This may affect part of the route.

Drinks will be available, as will the usual fayre of , cakes, confectionary, etc.





Directions

- 1. <u>From M6 (Junction 3)</u> Take A444 towards Coventry until second roundabout (approx 1 ½ miles). Take second exit onto Holbrook Way. At next roundabout take first exit stay in outside lane. At next junction turn right onto Burnaby Road. Over two sets of lights and at next roundabout take second exit onto Tamworth Road. Travel approx ½ mile and turn left into car park.
- 2. <u>From A45</u> Leave A45 at Allesley and take A4114 towards Coventry. At roundabout take second exit onto Coundon Wedge Drive. Over two roundabouts onto Long Lane (Garden Centre is on your right). At end of Long Lane turn right onto Tamworth Road, towards Coventry. Travel approx 200 metres and turn right into car park.
- From City Centre (Ring Road) Exit Ring Road at junction 9 (B4098 towards Keresley/Tamworth). Travel along B4098 for approx 2 miles. At third roundabout (Old Shepherd Pub to right) take first exit onto Tamworth Road. Travel approx ¹/₂ mile and turn left into car park.
